# Making our dreams come true

Since it became operational, the Fundación Gmp has contributed to **improve the lives of people with Intellectual Disabilities or Acquired Brain Damage in Spain**, carrying out different actions of direct support to institutions sharing this cause. The following are the general data of the number of projects implemented, financial investments, partners and total number of beneficiaries of the Foundation's work throughout these years.

2016 has been a historical year for the Fundación Gmp, with **543,000 Euro** invested in **15 social projects**. 345,000 Euro have been allocated through direct investment and 196,250 Euro in-kind, which has set a record since its creation in 2009.

As it can be seen in the table, the Fundación Gmp has steadily increased the number of projects and solidarity initiatives implemented every year since 2009, as well as the invest-


**ment,** reaching over 300,000 Euro of social investment per year and more than 4,500 direct beneficiaries each financial year.

Since 2009, 125 projects have been implemented, from which **34,801 people** have benefited directly, with a total investment of **3,094,236 Euro**. During 2016 **4,220 people** benefited.

Furthermore, Fundación Gmp has collaborated during 2016 with 94 NGO divided as follows: 50 related to Intellectual Disabilities, 12 related to Acquired Brain Damage and 32 from other fields.



# Lines of action in 2016

During this financial year, the Fundación Gmp has set the following lines of action in the implementation of its projects:

SPORTS, CULTURE AND LEISURE: We support and sponsor charity sport events such as races and tournaments, in order to raise funds to implement projects helping people with Intellectual Disabilities and Acquired Brain Damage in Spain.

**TRAINING:** We collaborate on training courses and Masters on fundraising and provision of business services for people with intellectual disabilities. This kind of training has a key impact in the capacity building of social organisations so they are more efficient in their management.

**LOAN OF PREMISES:** Every year, we allow different third-sector organisations to use our offices and meeting rooms for free.

PARTICIPATION IN SOCIAL MEDIA: We believe that joint efforts and resources are necessary when it comes to raising awareness about the situation of people with Intellectual Disabilities or Acquired Brain Damage. Therefore, we support the communication of various social campaigns through different media and social media. Furthermore, as a founding member of the Foundations for Science Council, we also collaborate and fund scientific projects in various



areas: research, dissemination, training, technology transfer, etc.

**INNOVATION:** Investment in new technologies and innovation is another line of action of the Fundación Gmp. This year we collaborated in the development of technologies helping the families of people affected by Acquired Brain Damage as well as in the design and implementation of an application to strengthen the autonomy of people with intellectual disabilities.

In this edition **52,100 Euro were raised for the creation of an open classroom under the ABA methodology for little boys and girls with autism**, at a standard school. An initiative of the ABAMUR association.

All 2,100 attendees to the festival were able to see the performances of artists such as Anthony Blake, Black & White Magic, Civi Civiac, Reynold Alexander, Sylvester the Jester, Carlos Adriano, Dani DaOrtiz, Arkadio, Huang Zheng, Juan Mayoral, Norbert Ferré and Javi Martín.

Companies like Heineken, Mercedes Benz Dimovil, Las Tres Brujas, Eulen Group, Axa, Comunique, Albaida or Las Colinas Golf & Country Club collaborated with the Festival by sponsoring it, and the City Council of Murcia and the 7 TV Región de Murcia, also contributed to the magic festival celebration. Indeed, the headquarters of the 7 TV Región de Murcia was the place chosen for the donation ceremony.

When Acquired Brain Damage appears in a family, all spheres of life are affected. In a flash, all the goals you had achieved in life fade away and it is a long and hard process to glimpse clear objectives other than "becoming again the person you once were". The project arose from the need that people who have suffered acquired brain damage can manage their own lives again and they are able to decide by themselves about the direction of their rehabilitation process, extending the learnings to their closer environment with the rehabilitation team's company and support.

#ElProyectoDeMiVida (The Project of my Life) focusses on the work in the personal and family spheres, in particular aspects relating to personal hygiene, diet, clothing, follow-up of medical advice, leisure and free time, transfers, mobility and shifts, home maintenance and the use of support products, as well as any other area deemed appropriated. In short, in the self-management of their daily lives independently.

The XVII Paddle Solidarity Tournament for Companies ended with a Closing Ceremony held at the **Moby Dick Club** in Madrid and hosted by the comedian and magician **Karim**. **Gloria Alemán**, President of the Fundación Gmp, handed over the funds collected to **José Félix Sanz Juez**, President of the Polibea Foundation. In his intervention, Sanz stressed the importance of actions like this one to disseminate the difficulties that people with Acquired Brain Damage have to face.

# Participation in social media

PLATAFORMA ESPAÑOLA POR EL DAÑO CEREBRAL ADQUIRIDO (SPANISH PLATFORM FOR ACQUIRED BRAIN DAMAGE)

On the occasion of the National Day of Acquired Brain Damage, the Plataforma Española por el Daño Cerebral Adquirido (Spanish Platform for Acquired Brain Damage), of which Fundación Gmp is a founding member, invited the Counsellor of Family and Social Affairs of the Community of Madrid, Carlos Izquierdo, to know first-hand the daily life of one of the rehabilitation centres for people with ABD. On the occasion of this campaign, the Platform Management proposed to the Counsellor the creation of a multidisciplinary work group to improve the care quality for the people affected.

Another relevant action of this campaign was the one carried out by the Atlético de Madrid football players, **Saúl Ñíguez** and **Koke Resurrección** who showed their support and solidarity in such a special day with the hash tag **#CONOZ-CODCA** on their social media.



#### FUNDACIÓN SERES

Since 2009, the Fundación Gmp belongs to the Fundación Seres. Seres promotes companies' commitment to the improvement of society through responsible actions in line with the company's strategy and generating value for everyone. This way, Fundación Gmp commits itself to Seres Foundation with the objective of transforming business reality in order to build a better society, pby promoting the company's role in the improvement of social life and favouring individual and collective learning.

## CONSEJO DE FUNDACIONES POR LA CIENCIA (FOUNDATIONS FOR SCIENCE COUNCIL)

In March 2014, the Consejo de Fundaciones por la Ciencia (Foundations for Science Council). This Council, of which Fundación Gmp is a founding member, consists of ten private foundations supporting and financing science from various areas: research, dissemination, training, technology transfer, etc. This entity takes part at the "Fundaciones por la ciencia" ("Foundations for Science Programme"), driven by the Fundación Española para la Ciencia y la Tecnología (Spanish Foundation for Science and Technology) (FECYT), whose objective is to stimulate the scientific participation of private foundations according to international criteria.

These foundations commit themselves to disseminating and promoting good practices to increase the participation in science; to cooperating in the initiatives proposed by the Council or some of the promoting foundations within their individual capacities and strategies; to carrying out joint activities to promote the implication of other foundations in science investment and the co-funding of joint projects; and to advising and cooperating in the seek and evaluation of research and development projects.

#### 'SOY CAPPAZ' ("I AM A CAPPABLE") BROADENS ITS AVAILABILITY TO 20 COUNTRIES

The Fundación Gmp, together with Fundación Mapfre, promote independent living of people with intellectual disabilities as well as their professional integration, and in order to contribute to this independence they have continued to work on their application "Soy Cappaz" ("I am a cappable"). The app is already available to be downloaded in Spain, Argentina, Brazil, Bolivia, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, United States, El Salvador, The Philippines, Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Dominican Republic, Turkey, Uruguay and Venezuela.

Other social organisations such as Garrigou Foundation, Down Spain or Plena Inclusión Madrid have also collaborated with this project.

The application, available at Google Play and the website www.soycappaz.com has a video informing of the application's different functions.





# **Awards**

## In 2016, The Fundación Gmp received five awards for its commitment to intellectual disability.

#### AUTFI SLAWARD

Fundación Gmp, thanks to the application "Soy Cappaz" ("I am cappable"), received the Autelsi Award 2016, given by the Asociación Española de Usuarios de Telecomunicaciones y de la Sociedad de la Información (Spanish Telecommunication and Information Society Users Association), to the Best Project on Social Commitment. With this app, the Fundación Gmp, together with Mapfre Foundation, improve the lives of people with Intellectual Disabilities. More than 1,300 people have already downloaded the application.

#### ASSIDO AWARD

The Fundación Gmp was awarded in 2016 by the Asociación para Personas con Síndrome de Down (Association for People with Down Syndrome), ASSIDO, for its support to the inclusion of people with Down syndrome. # **Others**



#### 1. INCE FOUNDATION STUDY

The Fundación Gmp has supported financially a study conducted by the Fundación INCE (Initiatives for Neuroscience Foundation) and directed by Antonio Gil-Nagel, neurologist and director of the Epilepsy Programme at Hospital Ruber Internacional, that connects intellectual disability with epilepsy.

The project analyses the connection between genetic causes and clinical manifestations in a group of patients with intellectual disability and epilepsy, with the objective to establish patterns of evolution, to know the prognosis and the particular response to different treatments available.

#### 2. ASSIDO CALENDAR

The Fundación Gmp sponsored **ASSIDO's 2017 Solidarity Calendar**. The almanac, with a price of 5 Euro, was called **"Inseparable"**, and portrayed scenes representing the bonds of friendship that arise at the Murcian organisation of people with Down Syndrome.

The Murcian Counsellor of Social Rights, **Conchita Ruiz**; the Managing Director for People with Disabilities of the region of Murcia, **Ana Guijarro**; the President of Assido, **Juan Carlos Sánchez**; the Director of the Fundación Gmp, **Francisco Fernández**; and the photographer from La Verdad, **Vicente Vicens**, author of all the pictures captured in the almanac, attended the calendar launch event.

## 3. PROJECT OF EARLY CARE FOR GIRLS AND BOYS WITH ID FROM 0 TO 6 YEARS OLD FROM LOW-INCOME FAMILIES

The Fundación Gmp strengthens the partnership with **Plena Inclusión Madrid** to help children with early care needs. Thus, the Foundation, that in 2014 already donated the funds raised with its Paddle Solidarity Tournament to this cause, **contributes with 25,000 Euro per year since 2014** and for the next three years, so low-income families can also give early care to their children between 0 and 6 years old.

Early care, which comprises treatments such as speech therapy, stimulation, physiotherapy, psychological intervention, psychomotricity and other complementary therapies to be given by specialists, is vital during the first few years of a child's life as it reduces the impact of Intellectual Disability or any other associated impairment, so they can have as normal a life as possible.

Thanks to this programme, **43 children** from low-income families received during **2016** the early care treatment they need.



#### 4. COLLABORATION WITH ALDEAS INFANTILES

The **Grupo Gmp** organised a solidarity campaign between the 12th December 2016 and the 5th January 2017, to provide school material and food for afternoon snacks to 177 children of the Day Centres that **Aldeas Infantiles SOS** Spain has in the **Community of Madrid**. With this campaign **500 kilos** of school material and food for afternoon snacks such as cookies, cereal, juices and pastries were collected.

# People Management

# The Fundación Gmp is committed to the reconciliation of their employees' working and family life

**Reconciliation:** In order to favour the reconciliation of their employees' working and family life, the Fundación Gmp implements a number of actions such as: flexible schedule, extra holidays in Christmas, extraordinary long weekends, childcare vouchers, restaurant vouchers, IT vouchers and health insurance for employees and their spouses and children

**Occupational health:** In this field, the Fundación Gmp carries out regular health screenings to its employees and provides training and information on risk prevention at the workplace.



# **Environment**

As a part of the Grupo Gmp Property SOCIMI, S.A., Fundación Gmp implements the Environmental Management System of the Grupo Gmp – which obtained the triple certification in 2009 in accordance with UNE-EN-ISO 14001:2004 in its offices buildings and business parks.

As a part of its commitment to Sustainability and Environment, the Grupo Gmp carries out various environmental awareness-raising campaigns. As an example, in 2012, the Group published and disseminated amongst its tenants a Manual of Environmental Policies: in 2013 it launched the information campaign 'Committed to the Environment' to make their employees adopt habits favouring a responsible use of water and energy; in 2014 it implemented a measure for the use of toilet paper with **Ecolabel** given to those products meeting the strictest requirements on environmental performance and quality; and in 2015 it obtained savings in energy consumption of 5,4% in electricity With the objective of minimizing the impact of its operations on the environment, the Fundación Gmp carries out various actions for the environment, which focus on the following indicators.





**CO**<sub>2</sub> **Emissions:** In line with the **Grupo Gmp** policy of reducing greenhouse gas emissions the **Fundación Gmp** obtained during 2016 a slight decrease in the emissions compared to 2015, verified by a company certified in accordance to **UNE-EN-ISO 14064-3:2012**. This way, out of the 1,528kg emitted in 2015 we have dropped down to 1,525 kg in 2016.



**Water:** Thanks to tools such as dual-flush cisterns in toilets or regulators for taps in offices, the volume of water consumed by the **Fundación Gmp** in 2016 has decreased in x%, from 11.20 m3 in 2015 to 10.82m3 in 2016.

**Paper:** The **Fundación Gmp** recycles the 25% of the paper it uses, 3% more than in 2015. The rest is handed in presentations or filed as documentation and invoices.



**Toners Management:** All the toners used by the **Fundación Gmp** are put directly into a container that the toners supplier (authorised manager) picks up for subsequent recycling.

**Selective Collection of Waste:** The **Fundación Gmp** separa los separates the waste generated through the containers available in the whole building. The waste is classified in: paper, plastic and organic.
